Kindergarten Enrollment

Kindergarten registration has begun. We are requiring all new students to complete online enrollments.

This system will replace several of our required forms that parents complete every school year. Please know that there may still be some paper copy forms that will need to be completed.

Please remember that we must have a copy of your child's birth certificate, *proof of residence, immunization record in order to enroll him/her in school.

*All of these documents must be included before an enrollment packet can be accepted. Please call 533-7626 if you have any further questions.

The new law requires that children must be 5 on or before September 1, 2022 to enroll in Kindergarten. If your child will turn 5 between Sep 2nd and Feb. 2nd, your child will be in a Transitional Kindergarten classroom.

*PG&E, water bill or mortgage/rental agreement are required as proof of residence.
