<u>Kindergarten Enrollment</u>

Kindergarten registration has begun. We are requiring all new students to complete online enrollments.

This system will replace several of our required forms that parents complete every school year. Please know that there may still be some paper copy forms that will need to be completed.

Please remember that we must have a copy of your child's birth certificate, *proof of residence, immunization record in order to enroll him/her in school.

*All of these documents must be included before an enrollment packet can be accepted. Please call 533-7626 if you have any further questions.

The new law requires that children must be 5 on or before September 1, 2024 to enroll in Kindergarten. If your child will turn 5 between Sep 2nd and June 2nd, your child will be in a Transitional Kindergarten classroom.

*PG&E, water bill or mortgage/rental agreement are required as proof of residence.

School Accountability Report <u>Card</u>

The 2022-2023 School Accountability Report Card (SARC) is available in the school office and on the district website at www.palermoschools.org. Under Proposition 98, California schools are required to prepare report cards annually and disseminate them to the public. The purpose of the SARC is to provide parents and the community with information about the condition of school facilities and safety, staff and curriculum, school finances, and student academic performance.


