Please make sure that your child arrives at school on time. The late bell rings at 8:25. Tardy students must come into the office for a pass before entering the classroom.

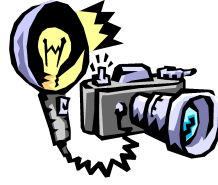
